

## **GOVERNOR'S ADVISORY BOARD FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY**

Meetings of the GABTR are held three times per year in various locations statewide in order to receive maximum public participation. Members are required to attend three or a majority of meetings per year, and it is important for members to observe this. If any member is unable to attend, he/she should notify the GABTR Liaison at least two weeks in advance of the meeting.

The role of a board member is to:

- Advise Department of Information Technology (DOIT) on the level of access and quality of standard Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) provided by Maryland Relay to the citizens of Maryland.
- Provide ongoing consultation for the development of strategies to inform the general public about Maryland Relay and how the program may be used to improve communication within and among its constituency.
- Provide a vehicle for public input into and concerning operation of Maryland Relay, development of innovative approaches/problem-solving strategies, and information on new service desired, etc.
